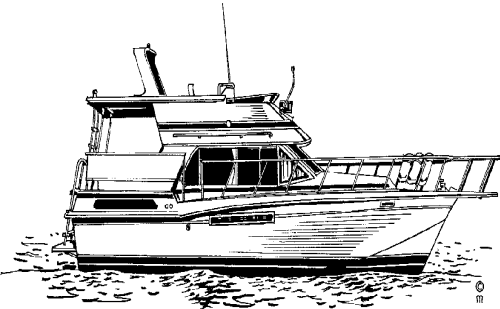

Tuition Rates

Classroom Training (minimum 4 hours)

One Person	\$125/hour
Second person (per person)	\$ 75/hour

Our vessel up to 39' (minimum 4 hours)

One person	\$160/hour
Second person (per person)	\$ 80/hour

Our vessel 40' & over (minimum 4 hours)

One Person	\$200/hour
Second person (per person)	\$100/hour

The fee for each program includes a two hundred dollar (\$200) non-refundable tuition deposit.

Your vessel up to 39' (minimum 4 hours)

Certification

A Chapman School certificate of completion is awarded to students who complete the course. The certificate may qualify a boat owner for marine insurance discounts.

Admission

- Registration Form must be completed and signed (by a parent or guardian if the applicant is under 18) and returned to the School along with a copy of a valid photo ID.
- Payment of full tuition is due with registration.
- Tuition includes books, supplies and laboratory fees.
- Tuition does not include housing, board or transportation.
- All costs are payable in U.S. currency only.
- The School accepts all major credit cards.

Transfer/ Refund Policy

- If registration is not accepted by the School, all payments made will be refunded.
- If cancellation is requested within three (3) business days after signing the Registration Form, all payments will be refunded in accordance with the buyer's right to cancel.
- If the School cancels the program due to insufficient student enrollment, I may be rescheduled to a future class, or all payments made will be refunded. In the event that I am unable to attend the class for which I am registered the following change/refund policy will apply:
1.If cancellation is requested more than three (3) business days after signing the Registration Form but, before the beginning of classroom instruction, the applicant is obligated for the non-refundable Tuition Deposit.

Each student is required to furnish his or her own deck shoes.

Transfer/Refund Policy..(Cont.)

2. Where notice is provided to the School more than fourteen (14) days before the start of class, a student may transfer to another class (if available), upon payment of a \$50.00 transfer fee.
3. Where notice is provided to the School less than 14 days before the start of class to cancel, or if the applicant does not arrive for the scheduled class, or if the applicant wishes to withdraw from class once classes have begun, the applicant may be obligated for the full amount of the tuition.
 - If a credit card was used as original method of payment, a convenience fee of 3.0% of the total amount refunded will apply for all transactions.
 - Applicable refunds are made within 30 days.

Student Housing

Student housing consists of dormitory apartments. Each unit contains a bedroom, convertible living room/ bedroom, bath, kitchenette and a covered porch. The number of students per unit during this program is generally a maximum of two. All units are furnished and equipped with refrigerator, counter top range and cooking utensils. Housing is offered on a space available basis. The School is not responsible for the loss of any personal property. Sorry, no pets.

Housing Fees

- Housing Fee \$80.00 (per night)
- For a second or third person in a party add \$20 per night/person.
- Housing includes utilities.

The School does not discriminate on the basis of age, sex, religion, race or ethnic origin in the administration of its policies & programs.

Housing Refund

- Housing fees are due 30 days prior to the start of class to reserve accommodations.
- If a student cannot attend the classes for which he/she is registered, housing fees are refundable.
- Once a student moves into the unit, no fees will be refunded
- If a credit card was used as the original method of payment, a convenience fee of 3.0% of the total amount refunded will apply for all transactions.
- In the event any student does damage to the accommodations, he or she will be responsible for the replacement cost and labor required to repair the damaged School property.

Curriculum, fees, expenses and other matters described herein are subject to change without notice at the discretion of the Chapman School of Seamanship. Currently enrolled students who have paid in full will not be affected by any such changes unless they change the date of enrollment to a future class.
